

## High-end TV Trainee Finder: New Look, New Talent 2018-19

In April 2018 we made our new cohort of High-end TV Drama Trainee Finder trainees ready and available to be placed onto productions paying into the High-End TV Skills Fund.

Running from 1 April 2018 to 31 2019, High-end TV Trainee Finder has 81 trainees placed across eight priority grades:

- Art department
- Camera
- Costume
- Editorial Post Production
- Hair and Make up
- Locations
- Floor Runner
- Production Office Runner

## Key Changes to the New Trainee Finder Programme 2018/19 - from September 2018

- Please contact Patrizia Berardi in the first instance to let her know the details of your
  production and the opportunity you are able to offer to those on the Trainee Finder scheme.
  She will send over details of which trainees are available for your production and /or send
  you a link to the trainees listed on the Hiive website as approved 2018/19 trainees
- We are able to support ideally four trainees per production from the above list up to 40 weeks overall. The 40 weeks of placement can be divided between more or less trainees e.g. two trainees at 20 weeks each or four trainees at 10 weeks each etc. with agreement from ScreenSkills.
- No other subsidy for other grades outside these departments is available if we are unable
  to offer a trainee from the pool due to none being available for your dates we are happy to
  discuss potential new trainees who could join the scheme subject to interview.
- ScreenSkills will reimburse the production £300 per week of trainee time up to a maximum of 40 weeks.
- ScreenSkills and the production company will sign an agreement between both parties. It is
  the responsibility of the production to negotiate the terms and conditions of the fixed term
  contract with the trainee who will now be paid via the productions payroll.

- Each of the 81 trainees has been interviewed by an industry professional working in the chosen department and will have taken part in a three day induction, to ensure they are placement ready.
- Every trainee will also take part in the High-end TV Trainee Finder Pastoral Care
  programme, which will include valuable additional training including, production safety
  passport, emergency first aid at work, supporting a carbon neutral production and finance
  for freelancers.
- A dedicated High-end TV Trainee Finder team available to support your production and your trainees to get the very best from the opportunity.

**Make a Move** continues to enable high-end TV drama productions to develop the skills and step up specific crew on the job, i.e. location assistants stepping up to unit managers, production secretaries stepping up to production coordinators or third ADs moving to second ADs. Fund-contributing productions can access up to £15,000 for the continuing professional development of their crew.

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
