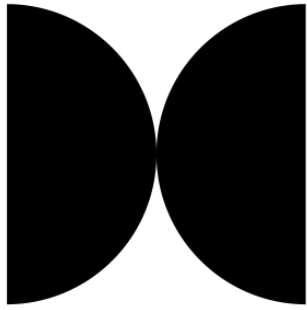

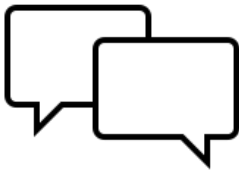


**Communication,

Another of the five (5) Working Groups is about communication, information and engagement.

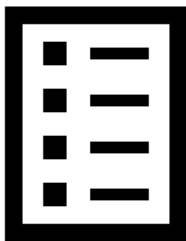
Engagement means to make sure everyone feels included and connected to the work being done.
